You only need to attend ONE orientation/advising session over the summer. It is imperative that you receive academic advising since you will be enrolling into your Fall courses with an advisor. ## 2. BEFORE ADVISING:

- Complete the Statement of Legal Residence: <u>https://www.reg.uci.edu/stlr/Welcome.do</u>
- Ensure that <u>all official transcripts</u> and any exam scores such as, AP, IB, SAT have been received by the UCI Office of Admissions by <u>JULY 1<sup>st</sup></u>. You can check "My Admissions" under 'My Schools' and 'My Tests' to review which transcripts/test scores have been received, and which ones are still required.
- Make copies of official exam scores and any college transcripts and bring them to the advising session. Proof of scores may be required for enrollment in certain courses.
- **READ** the **Transfer Pre-Orientation Website**: <u>http://orientation.uci.edu/tpow/</u>
  - This will provide you with some things you need to know about UCI and your academic career before you come to campus for advising.
