Exceptions to this rule may be allowed, with prior departmental approval, for EAP, UCDC Academic Intern Program, UC Center Sacramento Program.</p> <p>Residence Requirement for the Chc/Lat Major: A minimum of five upper-division courses required for the major must be completed successfully at UCI.</p> <p>Students are encouraged to pursue field research and write a substantial research paper on topics of their choice under the guidance of Chc/Lat faculty. Often, this project will grow out of issues examined in Chc/Lat 102W (Research Seminar).</p> <p>Research projects typically involve a combination of library research and fieldwork in the Chc/Lat community. Methods and analytical frameworks vary depending on the student and faculty advisors. Interested students should enroll in Chc/Lat 199.</p> <p>NOTE: All courses for the major must be taken for a letter grade.
