Students must submit an application to the Dept before the end of their JUNIOR year.</p> <p>In preparation, a prospective Honors student should identify a Pol Sci faculty who is willing to supervise the student's thesis. To graduate with PS Honors, you must have at minimum, a 3.0 GPA overall, a 2.0 GPA in your major, and 2.0 GPA in the upper-div courses in your major.</p> <p>Residency Requirement: At least 36 of the final 45 units completed by a student for the bachelor's degree must be earned in residence at the UCI campus.
